On 8th October 8 2018, the Deputy Head of the Central Anticorruption Bureau, Dr. Grzegorz Ociecek, assistant professor at the Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński University (UKSW), took part in the 4th European Cybersecurity Forum CYBERSEC 2018 in Krakow.
